Reminders

This week...

We started the week with our PE Gym lesson and explored making body shapes and balances using different parts of our body. In maths we have practised counting in 10s from any given number and used the PE ladders to jump along adding 10 more each time. We recorded number sentences adding 10, 20 and 30 more to a number and taking 10, 20 and 30 away from a given number. We thought carefully about Remembrance and helped to create a sun catcher poppy wreath using the poppies we made as a class. We collated collections of words about what Remembrance means to us and used "Wordfoto" app to create remembrance art using the words. We joined the school in two minutes silence to remember those that died in the wars. We have loved finding out about the Hindu Festival "Diwali, the Festival of Light. We made and coloured symmetrical Rangoli patterns, completed writing about a picture from the festival using the sentence starters, "I see..., I think, I wonder", and we also made our own diva lamps out of salt dough and decorated them with sequins and beads. We listened carefully to the story about Rama and Sita and sequenced the pictures from the story and wrote sentences to re-tell the events. We thought carefully about the importance of this story and how Diwali is celebrated We finished the week thinking about Children in Need and wrote about what we are grateful for and thought about how we can help others.
