This week...

We have had another busy, fun-filled week in Year 2. We started the week practising our 'Under the Sea' dance ready for our Show and See afternoon and we also met with our pupil-voice groups.

In Maths we have been measuring using standard units (centimetres), remembering to always start at 0cm when using a ruler. We also considered which unit of measure was the best to measure different lengths e.g a road = km, a pin = mm, a pencil = cm. We made an estimation of the length of different classroom objects, which we then measured accurately. We also measured different body parts and used our knowledge of ordinal numbers to sequence the lengths from shortest to longest.

In literacy we have been creating our own pirate poems based on the poem 'Solomon Grundy.' We have also been exploring rhyme and identifying rhyming couplets within texts.

During our topic work we have used atlases, globes and digital maps to locate oceans and seas on our World maps. Also, we became Scientists this week and investigated which objects sink and float. We made sure that we carried out a fair test, made a sensible prediction before beginning our investigation and also explained our results with supporting evidence. What a roarsome week in Year 2!
