



Colhuw Nursery class news at Ysgol y Ddraig Week Ending: Friday 10th May 2019

We started our week by introducing our new topic, “How many pebbles on the beach?” and shared our own experiences of visiting a beach during circle time. There were lots of exciting ideas about sharks and dolphins and we are looking forward to seeing where our interests take us during this topic!

We played a game on the interactive whiteboard where we had to guess the pictures of objects that can be found on the beach including beach huts, deck chairs, seagulls, ice-creams, sand and the sea and we practised lots of topic language and vocabulary together. We looked at books about visits to the beach and enjoyed listening to the story of “Sharing the Shell” by Julia Donaldson.

We have started to create our topic role-play area which is a beach café and shop, selling ice-creams. We have enjoyed dressing up in beach clothes including goggles, rubber rings, flippers and sunglasses. We have worked on reading and recognising numbers and their amounts and practised writing our names. We enjoyed a ‘getting to know you’ Circle Time using Welsh language, asking and answering the questions, “Pwy wyt ti?” (Who are you?). We finished the week with a PE lesson on the big playground, where we practised rolling, throwing and catching balls with a friend and played ball games.
