



Colhuw Nursery class news at Ysgol y Ddraig

Friday 23rd November 2018

This week we have enjoyed painting pictures of a hedgehog – we looked carefully at the shape of the body and nose and counted his legs. We used combs to make a spiky texture on the body. When the paintings were dry, we used a snipping technique around the edge of the hedgehog to make spines, making sure we were holding the scissors correctly. We talked about hibernation and we chose an animal from the story “Don’t hog the hedge” to make a nest for, using leaves and twigs.

We have been identifying numbers and enjoyed hearing the story of “Spotty Seven”, a giraffe with 7 spots, and have practised counting out 7 objects. We played a game where we rolled a dice and read the number on the dice and had to collect that number of bean bags. We could then take that many shots at the goal, to help us to understand the value of the number. We have learnt the sound of the letter “a” and have been playing games to identify the letter “m” and the letter “a” in our phonic area.

Today in our gymnastics lesson we have been practising making body shapes and playing a game called “spot to spot” which involved balancing on different parts of the body.
