This week we set up a "Car Wash" and role-played exchanging money for the service. The children loved cleaning the cars and there was a steady stream of business! We have worked on reading and recognising numbers and naming 2D shapes. We have also practised taking building blocks apart and joining them together and building towers of a given number of blocks.

As part of our observation of the changing of seasons, we have started to talk about "Harvest time" and to learn the songs, "Autumn Leaves are Falling Down" and "Dingle Dangle Scarecrow".

We have continued sharing the stories of "Percy the Park Keeper" and used masks and story props to inspire some creative play and discussion in our indoor and outdoor role-play areas.
