Welcome back to the Summer Term! This week we really enjoyed sharing our Easter holiday News with our friends – we sat in a circle and took turns to speak. We welcomed new friends to our Nursery and have enjoyed getting to know each other. Everybody has settled very well.

This week we have worked on writing our names and forming letters carefully. We also drew pictures of ourselves and talked about our drawings. We watched video clips of a Grand Prix race and found out about being a mechanic. We set up a garage role-play area outside and loved working on the cars at the mechanic station and fixing the cars in the “pit stop” during car and bike races. We built vehicles using the small and large blocks and we drew pictures of different methods of transport. We used the cars to drive around numbers to practice number formation. We set up a race circuit and held our own Grand Prix at the end of the week! We talked about the position we came in the race, using the language first, second and third. It was great fun!

We set up a “Water world” using pipes and tubes to link the trays together. We explored transporting the water between the trays and talked about what we were doing.

Next week we will be starting our new topic, “How many pebbles on the beach?” – we will be exploring this question and lots more about the seashore this term, including finding out about plants and animals that live on the seashore. We will talk to the children and gather their ideas and interests next week to plan our topic.
