This week we have been taking part in activities to help us understand about the importance of keeping safe on the internet, with the message to always ask a grown up about any pop up messages and videos that appear on a tablet, computer or mobile phone while we are using them. Buddy the dog helped the children to discuss different scenarios and how to handle them, including never talking to strangers on the internet. The children loved the song, "Ask a grown up" and made a painted handprint as a promise to always use the Internet safely.

We have been learning all about the celebration of Chinese New Year and we have found out about the traditions and foods. We painted an orange and made a wish to hang on our blossom tree. We used tweezers and pegs to pick up noodles and made marks to copy some Chinese writing and numbers in coloured rice. We watched video clips about the celebrations and we also role-played a dragon parade, dressing up as a dancing dragon in teams, accompanied by musical instruments. We shared the story about the Great Race which created the zodiac, and we role-played the race across the river using ordinal numbers. In our PE lesson we explored some traditional ribbon dancing.
