









## Dosbarth Colhuw - Home Learning Spring Term 2019 "Do dragons exist?"

<p>Develop recognition of numbers 1-5 (and beyond for those who are ready).</p>	<p>Design your own Family Coat of Arms to go on a Knight's shield.</p> 	<p>Think of some questions to ask a knight</p> 	<p>Practise writing your name.</p> <p>This could be writing on paper or in glitter / flour / mud / sand etc.</p>
<p>Bring in a story book from home that is about dragons or a castle adventure. Please label the book or bring in a named bag.</p> 	<p>Make a model or picture of a castle.</p> 	<p>Teach a family member the game, "What's the time Mr Dragon?" that we have played in Nursery. Remember to count your steps carefully!</p> 	<p>Make a visit to a castle with a grown up and take some photographs to share with the class.</p> 
<p>Read and discuss your weekly story book and write a comment about your enjoyment of the story in the Reading Record.</p>	<p>Make a hand or finger puppet of a dragon e.g. using a sock, a wooden spoon, paper bag etc.</p> 	<p>Draw and colour a dragon using crayons, ICT, chinks, paints, pencils or colla--</p> 	<p>Practise counting up to five objects (and beyond if ready) in many different situations.</p>
