<p>Develop recognition of numbers 1-5 (and beyond for those who are ready).</p>	<p>Make a visit to a beach and take some photos or collect beach 'treasures' such as shells and seaweed for our 'Investigation Area'. Think about what you can see, hear, smell and feel.</p> 	<p>Build a sandcastle and take a photo of your creation and bring it to school to share with our class.</p> 	<p>Practise writing your name.</p> <p>This could be writing on paper or in glitter / flour / mud / sand etc.</p>
<p>Bring in a story book from home that is related to our topic to share with the class. Please label the book or bring in a named bag.</p>	<p>Paint a picture of a beach scene.</p> 	<p>Make a boat out of any materials that can float in water. Bring it to school before the 19th June to take part in a Nursery class boat race.</p> 	<p>Make a model or paint a picture of a lighthouse.</p> 
<p>Read and discuss your weekly story book and write a comment about your enjoyment of the story in the Reading Record.</p>	<p>Can you make a model / paint a picture of a creature that lives in the sea or on the seashore?</p>	<p>Explore objects that float and sink in a bowl of water or in the bath. Can you predict which objects will float and which will sink?</p>	<p>Practise counting up to five objects (and beyond if ready) in many different situations.</p>
