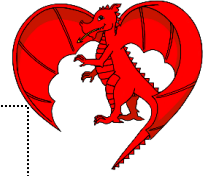

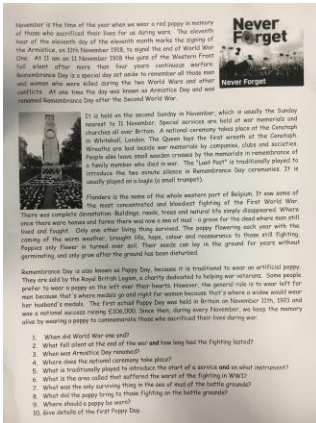


## Dosbarth Hafren a Dosbarth Caerffili

Week Ending: Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November

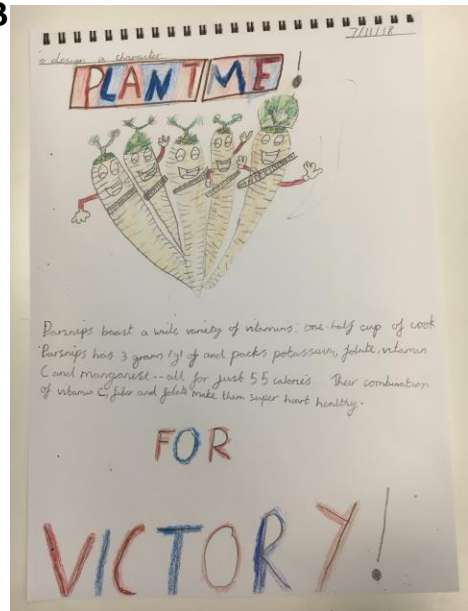

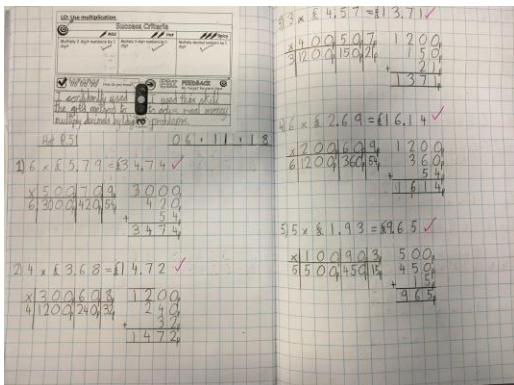
