What we have been doing

Due to the snow this is our first newsletter since the half term holiday, which seems a long time ago now. We hope all the children had a special time in the snow.

Over the past two weeks we have been learning about St David and how we celebrate St David's day. The children have made daffodils, leeks and have practiced making circle shapes when chalking on a sheep template.

This week we explored the snow by collecting it in buckets and investigating how we can make it melt.

Last week we learnt a Welsh lullaby Heno, Heno. On Tuesday we sang it to all the older children as part of our Foundation Phase Eisteddfod.

After finding out about Welsh cawl the children went on a shopping trip (in our outdoor area) to buy all the ingredients to make cawl. The children had to give the correct amount of 1p coins to match the price of each ingredient. The children enjoyed role playing making cawl.

We have explored making Welsh Castles using cut out shapes. When doing this we talked about the shapes touching like bricks and stones touch in castle walls.

The children have been busy practising writing their names for a very special card.
