We shared the story of "Amazing Eight", a super spider who was very creative with her web making skills to attract visitors to the zoo. We played games to help us to recognise the numbers. We have learnt the sound of the letter "s" and have been playing games to identify the letters "m", "a" and "s".

Today in our PE lesson we have been practising moving and clapping to rhythm and using our bodies to travel in a variety of ways.
