### Reminders

We have really enjoyed developing our arts and craft skills by creating a range of mini beasts and flowers for our new topic display, 'The Scented Garden.' We explored different materials, followed step-by-step instructions and used our own imaginations. We had great fun! We completed a Welsh carousel this week which focused on the topic 'dillad' (*clothes*). We learnt lots of new vocabulary and we reinforced this by playing splat with our friends. We also learnt how to ask and answer the question 'Beth wyt ti'n gwisgo?' (*What are you wearing?*) and replied with 'Dwi'n gwisgo' (*I'm wearing*). We challenged ourselves to extend our answers by describing the clothing and giving reasons why we are wearing particular items of clothing, referring to the weather. Our Helpwr Heddiw question and answers are really developing and we practised this by creating an animation on Puppet Pals. We recorded our Welsh conversations with our partners, trying to speak clearly and with correct pronunciation.
