We have also learnt about the life cycle of a plant. We now know that seeds and bulbs can be planted by humans, animals and even the wind.

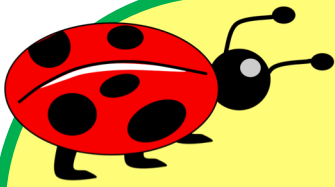
We have continued our work on Jack and the Beanstalk this week, describing the differences between Jack and the Giant and using the PuppetPals app to re-tell the story.
