### This week...

The whole school has engaged in a 'Food and Fitness' week. We explored the different food groups to help us understand the importance of having a balanced diet, using the Eat Well chart. Also, we became designers and created unique ideas for a new healthy snack in the shape of a mini beast. We had to label our designs and then make a final decision as to which healthy mini beast we would like to make next week.

We conducted an investigation to find out how much sugar is in different drinks. We made predictions and used weighing scales to accurately measure the different amounts of sugar. We displayed our results in a bar chart on Hwb and used a tool called 'Mix' to analyse the data.

In Maths this week, we have focused on capacity. We estimated the size of different puddles and then carefully measured the accurate volume to help us determine how close our estimation was.

In Literacy we created our own descriptive poem, using our 5 senses. We imagined our own Scented garden and used adjectives to create descriptive phrases. This was to help engage the reader and encourage them to picture our Scented Garden.
