### This week...

In our Maths carousel we have been working on our 3 times table. We used cubes to create arrays to solve multiplication number sentences. We also drew a large number line outdoors and practised frog hopping on all multiples of 3, in readiness to help us solve word problems based on the 3 times table.

As a whole school we have been celebrating 'Hooray for Humanities' this week. In Year 2 we have focused on an influential Welsh lady called Betsi Cadwaladr and learnt about how she helped to change hospitals for the better. We compared Victorian hospitals to hospitals today and sequenced ambulances from over the last century in chronological order, using our place value knowledge. We also had great fun learning basic first aid.

We have focused on two countries Mexico and Poland this week and looked at the similarities and differences between the countries and their culture. We recorded our results in a Venn diagram. We also located these countries on a map along with 5 other countries that are taking part in the World Cup.
