<p>Design your dream garden and consider what plants and flowers you would use. Label the key features of your garden.</p>	<p>Create a plant/flower or minibeast fact file. Include drawings, photographs and information you have found out.</p>	<p>Can you draw a symmetrical drawing of a minibeast or flower.</p>	<p>Draw or paint a picture of your favourite flower or plant. Label your picture with the special features of the flower and plant.</p>
<p>Practise learning your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. If you know these well challenge yourself to learn your 3 and 4 times tables.</p>	<p>Go on a walk in the local area and find different types of plants and flowers. Can you describe what they look like</p>	<p>Create a collage using only natural materials collected from your garden or local area.</p>	<p>Practise reading the HFW wall at speed and also learn how to spell these tricky words.</p>
