- Been to our second Pupil Voice Group meetings, contributing to developing action plans to enhance our school.
- Rounding 3-digit numbers to the nearest 10.
- Investigating ways to reach a total number by adding 4 small numbers.
- Revised number concepts covered this term e.g. 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 times table, adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers, doubling/halving 2-digit numbers, bonds to 100, partitioning 3-digit numbers, using frog hops to count up when subtracting two 2-digit numbers using the middle multiple of ten and exploring 3D shapes.
- Logged onto ActiveLearn to play our allocated games.
- Played Dodgeball in PE.
- Developed obstacle courses in Forest Schools.
- Answered comprehension questions about a Halloween story.
- Practised our handwriting by selecting and copying a Halloween poem.
- Talked about Firework safety and created our own set of rules and safety posters.
- Completed our board games about overcoming obstacles in our RE topic.
- Ended our Hindu topic by learning about the annual celebrations for Ganesha's birthday and hearing some stories about him.
- Enjoyed relaxing and strengthening our bodies with some Yoga in PE.
- Created our own Spells, using time connectives, bossy recipe verbs and different quantities of strange ingredients.
