### We have been:

Exercising in our 5-a-day sessions.

Brushing our teeth with the Brush Bus.

Walking our daily mile.

Working hard in our RWI groups.

Participating in group reading activities.

Using chrome books and iPads to play number and phonic games.

Recognising, copying, continuing and creating repeating patterns.

Recapping months of the year and creating a pictogram of our class birthdays.

Reading and interpreting pictograms.

Creating group pictograms of the days we were born.

Adding and subtracting 1-digit numbers to a 2-digit number and finding the pattern e.g.  $5+3=8$ ,  $15+3=18$ ,  $25+3=28$  etc...  
/  $7-2=5$ ,  $17-2=15$  etc...

Completing missing numbers off a 100-number square.

Partitioning numbers e.g.  $27 = 20 + 7$

Finding numbers on a beaded number line.

Finding 1 more/less and 10 more/less than numbers up to 100.

Commemorating 70 years of the NHS by knowing who started it, learning about the famous Welsh nurse from the past: Betsi Cadwaladr, bandaging up our friends like wounded soldiers and drawing/sequencing ambulances over the decades.

Writing our names in hieroglyphics on our painted, salt dough cartouches.

Attending a travel show in the school hall, looking at the countries studied by other year groups.

RE - Learning a dance and making a headdress for next week's parade to celebrate the Buddhist festival Esala Perahera.

PSE - changes of us and our friends throughout the year
