Home Learning activities

To prepare for year 2, children can:

- practise their independent writing, using their Fred Fingers for spelling and using correct letter formation and at a consistent size.
- Practise & enjoy reading by borrowing books from the library / reading books from home.
- Practise reading and writing numbers to 100, number bonds to 10 and 20, doubles & halves to 20, counting in 2s, 5s, 10s, addition and subtraction of small numbers, counting small amounts of money and giving change from 10p / 20p, reading analogue and digital clocks for o'clock and half past (quarter past & to when ready).
