Please try to complete all four corners of the grid on a weekly basis and complete a minimum of three of the other activities throughout the Autumn term (Sept-Dec).

<p>Read the school reading book and ask a grown up to comment in your reading record.</p>	<p>Can you draw an aerial plan (bird's eye view) of your own bedroom including a key?</p>	<p>Interview someone who has lived in your community for a long time, perhaps an elderly relative or neighbour you know well. What changes have they seen? Which things are better or worse today? Write down your findings to share with the class.</p>	<p>Learn double facts- double all numbers up to 10 For example <math>1+1=2</math> <math>2+2=4</math>... <math>6+6=12</math>, <math>7+7=14</math>...<math>9+9=18</math> <math>10+10=20</math></p> <p>Practise my number facts by completing challenges on ActiveLearn.</p>
<p>Can you research facts from the internet or books in the library about Llantwit Major in the past. Record your findings in a way so the information can be shared with your class. E.g poster, list, film clip.</p>	<p>Make a leaflet, poster or short film all about your local community. Include drawings, photographs and information explaining what people could do if they visited Llantwit Major.</p>	<p>Think about the people who help us in our community. Draw or paint a picture of them in their uniform and explain their job. (Doctor, Firemen, Lollipop lady etc)</p>	<p>Imagine you have been asked to design a new building for Llantwit Major. Draw a design of your building, labelling materials and features. Perhaps, you may like to make a 3D model of your building.</p>
<p>Learn number bonds of 10/20 - pairs of numbers that make 10/20. For example <math>0+1</math>, <math>1+9</math>, <math>2+8</math>, <math>3+7</math>,.....<math>11+9</math>, <math>12+8</math>, <math>13+7</math></p>	<p>Draw your route to school by creating a map. You may want to include directions to explain your journey and label key features that you see on route.</p>	<p>Visit a local shop with your grown up. Write a shopping list before you go. Pay for your shopping and work out your change. Take photos to share with your friends in school. You may want to type up your shopping list on Hwb.</p>	<p>Practise reading the HFW wall at speed and also learn how to spell these tricky words.</p>
