<p>Read the school reading book and ask a grown up to comment in your reading record.</p>	<p>Can you draw an aerial plan (bird's eye view) of your own bedroom including a key?</p>	<p>Interview someone who has lived in your community for a long time, perhaps an elderly relative or neighbour you know well. What changes have they seen? Which things are better or worse today? Write down your findings to share with the class.</p>	<p>Learn to add/subtract 10, 20 and 30 to any 2-digit number. Can you record the number sentences too.</p> <p>E.g. $43 + 10 = 53$ $43 + 20 = 63$</p>
<p>Think about the vehicles we saw on our traffic survey morning. Can you build a 3D mode of transport - car, plane, train, bus etc?</p>	<p>Make a leaflet, poster or short film all about your local community. Include drawings, photographs and information explaining what people could do if they visited Llantwit Major.</p>	<p>Think about the people who help us in our community. Draw or paint a picture of them in their uniform. (Doctor, Firemen, Lollipop lady etc)</p>	<p>Can you write directions from your house to a local feature (shop, church, leisure centre, park) using directional language, e.g turn right. You may also want to use time connectives such as first, next, then, after, and finally.</p>
<p>Practise learning your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. If you know these well challenge yourself to learn your 3 and 4 times tables.</p>	<p>Design your own fantasy house and consider what would it be made of? Label the key features of your house.</p>	<p>Visit a local shop with your grown up. Write a shopping list before you go. Pay for your shopping and work out your change. Take photos to share with your friends in school. You may want to type up your shopping list on Hwb.</p>	<p>Practise reading the HFW wall at speed and also learn how to spell these tricky words.</p>
