<p>Can you create a fact file about a minibeast of your choice? Use the internet or fact books to find out what the minibeast eats, where it lives or other interesting facts.</p>	<p>Find a recipe for a fruit kebab/smoothie and make one at home. Write up your ingredients and instructions to share with your friends. You may want to include a photograph!</p>	<p>Think about what you can see, hear, touch, smell and taste in your garden or local park. Create a poem or song based on your ideas.</p>	<p>Design your own fantasy garden and include a key or label the different areas of the garden clearly.</p>
<p>Log on to Active Learn and Mathletics to practise your number skills through interactive games.</p>	<p>Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden/park and create a graph to show the different types of minibeasts you found and quantity.
