



Year 3 Class News at Ysgol y Ddraig

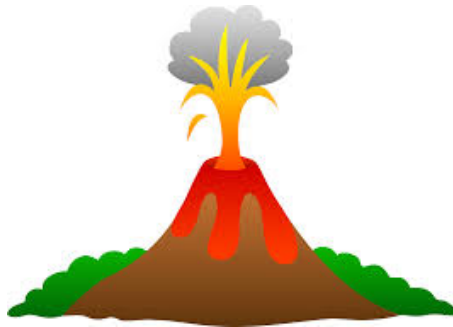
Week ending 25th May 2018
