

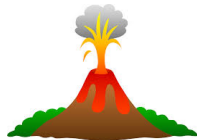


Year 3 Class News at Ysgol y Ddraig

This week...

On Tuesday we took part in our first cricket lesson with Coach Hugh from Cricket Wales. We learned about throwing and catching and played team games. In maths we have been using our data skills and learning about pictograms where one symbol represents one unit. We have added data to and constructed our own pictograms and interpreted the results. We have also been thinking about which unit of measurement to use when weighing- Kilograms or grams. We have practised converting Kg to g and g to Kg. We have continued with our topic 'Tremors'. We have added dates to a time line showing volcano eruptions around the world, used QR codes to research famous volcanoes, created volcano fact files and made our own volcano 'Top Trumps' games. In Science we investigated how sand is made and wrote about how we carried out the experiment and what we found out.
