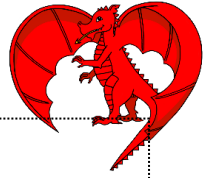


# Spring Term Class News

This week, the pupils in Dosbarth Penfro and Dosbarth Cleddau have continued working on their topic, The Blue Abyss. In **Literacy** We have researched facts about the famous diver and oceanographer Jacques Cousteau. We have used our research to plan and write a biography of his life. We have read the story 'The fantastic under sea life of Jacques Cousteau' by Don Yaccarino. We have continued work on our seascape collages. In **Numeracy**, we have been converting units of capacity (ml and l) and weight (g and kg). We have also read different scales to measure weight and capacity. We have used Active Learn games Diamond Demolition and Smack the Shack. We have continued to work on a range of number skills included in our Big Maths tests. These include times tables, place value adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers. We introduced our new Welsh topic 'Salwch' (illnesses) and revised parts of the body and practised sentence patterns.
