## School Uniform

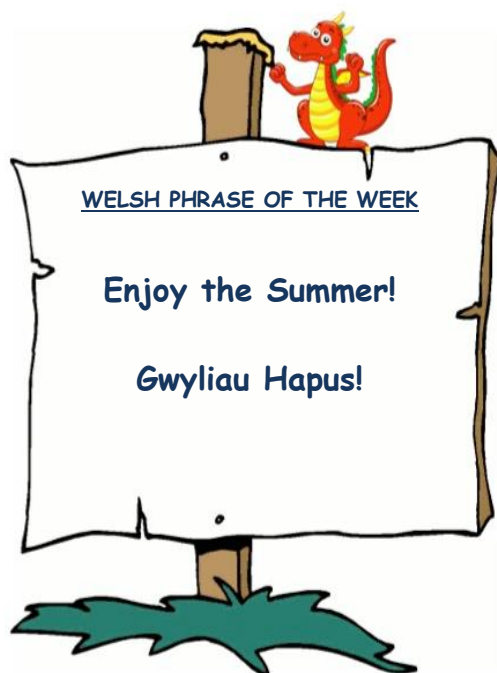
As many parents will be spending time over the summer holidays purchasing school uniform, we would like to remind you about the clothing requirements for September.
