We learnt how to write an informal letter. We chose someone that we wanted to say 'thank you' to and wrote a letter telling them why we were grateful. We arranged our ideas into paragraphs and tried to make our writing interesting to read by using a range of sentence starters. In maths we have learnt how to measure objects in cms using a ruler. We had to predict the length of items and then record the actual measure. We have also created mazes and practised using positional language to direct our friends. For our enrichment day we had a very special letter from Father Christmas, sending us a box of equipment with wires, batteries and bulbs and asking us to explore how to light his sleigh. We created circuits using the equipment and drew the electric circuit for Father Christmas, using symbols. We also investigated shadows and found out what happened when the light source moved closer and further away from an object. In Welsh we asked each other, "Beth sy'n bod?"(What's the matter?) and explained our ailments, such as tummy ache, headache, sore throat etc. In PE we used equipment to make body shapes at different levels and sequenced sets of movements and performed them for our friends.
